#### **Hello:**

With warmer weather and longer daylight, Iqn looking forward to seeing our cars come out to our next meeting on April 2nd. We have numerous shows and some flea mar-

kets happening in April. Check our club event list as well as page 3 & 4 of this issue for other auto related events in our area

On a recent snowy Friday, Stace Leichliter and I worked some grease under our finger nails while trying to find out why my fathers £8 Tudor leaked so much oil out the rear main bearing. The night before the storm, John Daley was kind enough to put the car on the lift for us in the club garage. On Friday morning, after dropping the pan and the rear main bearing cap, the only things that we found were a loose and pitted drain tube and an extra .001+clearance in the rear main bearing. We installed a new drain tube and removed the last shim to tighten up the bearing clearance. So far, this seems to have greatly reduced the oil leak. It still leaves a small spot of oil after a run but nothing excessive anymore.

The point of this being that these cars are fairly easy to work on. If you are leaking oil, it can be fixed. Most repairs on these cars are easy so lets get our cars ready to roll for the upcoming events!



Add to the interest in this new car by completely covering your windows and doors on Saturday—a week before the showing. Do this with white paint, whitewash or white muslin.




LAY RUGS ON FLOOR

You can rent these rugs at small cost and you will find them a good investment. Put them under the new Ford car to add richness and dignity to the display. Be sure to use dark rugs. Dark blue or black is best.



GET NAMES AND ADDRESSES

Select an attractive girl or salesman to hand out Booklet Cards and Descriptive Folders to prospects as they come in the door. Station another girl or salesman at the exit to collect these cards as the prospects go out.




ARRANGE TO USE POSTERS

Be sure to utilize the window posters we are furnishing you for use before and during the official showing. They will help to bring people into your showrooms.



USE THE FEATURE SIGNS

We are furnishing you with attractive signs emphasizing the features of the new Ford car. Be sure to use these in your display on Friday, the day of the official showing but not before.



MARK ENTRANCES AND EXITS

Mark entrance and exit plainly on both sides of the doors so that people can pass in and out quickly. Prepare to handle a big crowd. You want to make it easy for people to see the car.




BUY LOTS OF CREPE PAPER

Use this crepe paper to carry out the blue and white color scheme and make your showroom attractive. Remember that future sales depend on the way you display this new car on the first day.



GIVE THE SPEAKER A PROMINENT PLACE

Station him near the car in a central position in your showroom. Be sure to hang the big Specification Chart near him so he can refer to it in his talk.



HAVE PLENTY OF LIGHT

Install extra lights if needed to show the new car at its best. Remember that many people will not be able to get close to the car because of the crowd. Make it easy for them to see every detail.

Most factory photos of dealer showrooms display lots and lots of flowers. It was customary for a bank or other business to send flowers congratulating them on the new models.

With all the "foot traffic," it was good business sense to include local business people in the celebration.

Most dealers would only get one or two new cars to display so there was plenty of room to walk around the cars and accommodate a large crowd.

Dealers that were not fortunate enough to display a new model could only show the large showroom posters of what the car looked like.
