Dues are now due. Roster update forms are requested from all members.


50/50 was won by Carmen Morelli and donated back to the club.

# In Memory Ben Brzoza

Ben Brzoza died peacefully on Tuesday, Jan. 17, 2017 after a four-year battle with brain cancer. He was 83.

Born in Philadelphia, he was the son of Roman and Mary Brzoza, and a longtime resident of Bensalem. A 1951 graduate of Bensalem High School, he was a member of the 1950 Championship football team. He served in Korea with the Army Corps of Engineers. After returning home he attended Temple University evening classes under the GI Bill. He worked in construction until 1976 when he opened his own real estate office, Liberty RE.

He was the beloved husband for 56 years of Betty (Smith); the loving father of Ben Jr. and Beth Ann; the cherished Dzia Dzi (grandfather) of Danielle Brzoza, Tom Brzoza, Emily Tarnoff and Ashley Tarnoff; and brother-in-law of Robert Smith and Susan and Jim Creevey. He also is survived by his sister, Rose Baldyga; his brother, Joseph Brzoza; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his sister, Joan Gittings.

Remembered by his humor, kindness, and honesty, he had a smile you couldn't forget. He enjoyed traveling the world, spending time with family, grandchildren and friends, gardening, collecting anything old, and was a die hard Philadelphia Eagles fan. He enjoyed country and polka music.

A devout Catholic, he was a founding member of St. Ephrem Church, where he served as an usher. A member of the St. Ephrem Senior Group, he was affectionately known as Mr. Sunshine. He will be greatly missed.

Relatives and friends are invited to attend his visitation from 9:30 a.m. until the Mass of Christian Burial at 11 a.m. Friday, Jan. 20, at St. Ephrem Church, 5400 Hulmeville Road, Bensalem. Interment will be held privately at a later date.



## GETTING TO KNOW YOU.....



When Tom Brokaw wrote his book, The Greatest Generation. he could have included our friend and fellow PASR life member. William (Bill) Grun. Bill was raised in the Frankford section of Philadelphia and graduated from Frankford High School. After graduation, he went off to Penn State University to study Industrial Arts. Two

weeks before the bombing of Pearl Harbor, Bill enlisted in the U. S. Navy, thus putting his PSU studies on hold. Bill never went to Boot Camp but was immediately sent to Cape May, New Jersey where he served as a cook and carpenter on the Mine Sweeper USS CanaryASC25. His next assignment was at the Naval Air Station in Atlantic City and then Submarine School in Brigantine, New Jersey. His time at the shore ended with his assignment to the destroyer escort USS Seiberlig DD441 and saw extensive combat action in the Pacific. At war's end in 1945, Bill returned to PSU, graduating with honors in 1947.

Bill began teaching Industrial Arts in the Bristol Township School System. After two years he moved to the Abington School District where he taught for 31 years. While at Abington he served on numerous curriculum committees and helped build a model Industrial Arts program. He served as Department Chair at Abington High School North Campus from 1964 until his retirement.

While teaching and raising a family with two daughters, and completing a Master's Degree from PSU, Bill re-enlisted in the Navy Reserve and served at Willow Grove Naval Air Station. He retired from the Navy as a Lt. Commander after 28 years of service.

At 96 years young, Bill is a widower. His oldest daughter recently retired after 40 years of service at the Neshaminy Manor in Warrington. His youngest daughter, an ordained Presbyterian minister, followed her father's Navy footsteps and is a Two-star Admiral, responsible for all Navy chaplains. For the past 25 years Bill has volunteered every Friday at Holicong Middle School teaching Tech Ed. He has been directly involved in public education for over 70 years! Bill has taken courses at Princeton Seminary, teaches Sunday School classes at Doylestown Presbyterian Church, and is involved in Mission work. He contributes time to the Bucks County Conservancy and worked with the Habitat for Humanity after Hurricane Sandy.

When asked how he stays so young, he quickly responded "Keep a positive attitude and keep your faith." His hobbies include biking as shown on a recent TV special, and showing his 1931 Model A Ford. Bill's PA Driver License has recently been renewed for four more years, good until age 100! Bill is a quiet caring gentleman who truly represents the Greatest Generation. Thank you Bill for your service to our country and the many young people whose lives you have touched.




