

Here are the top 10 distractions involved in fatal car crashes:




Deadly DrivingDistractions

Erie Insurance analyzed national police report data to determine the most common driving distractions involved in fatal car crashes. The data is from the Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), a nationwide census of fatal motor vehicle traffic crashes maintained by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. The data is from 2012–2016.

Of the more than **172,000**

people killed in car crashes over the past 5 years one IN TEN were in crashes where at least one of the drivers was distracted




